- Read about the Lost Colony of Roanoke and then write a paragraph about what you think happened to the people of the colony.
- Submit the paragraph into google classroom on a google doc.

Jamestown and Plymouth

- Read about Jamestown and Plymouth then create a Venn Diagram and compare and contrast the two successful settlements.
- Then draw a map of what you think Jamestown or Plymouth looked like with an explanation of what it was and how it was used. Make sure to include a Mill by a river, a Blacksmith's shop, Stables, Stocks, a Meeting House, a School house, a common area with a well, and houses with gardens or farmland.
- Create 3 trading cards of people from this time like John Smith, Pocahontas, Squanto, Sir Walter Raleigh, Queen Elizabeth I, King Charles II, Metacomet, Olaudah Equiano, Nathaniel Bacon, William Bradford, John Winthrop, John Rolfe, Lord Baltimore, John Mason, William Penn, James Oglethorpe, Duke of York, Roger Williams, George Carteret, Anne Hutchinson, etc. Use the template that is provided.
- Fill out a map of the original 13 Colonies

Paper bag book of the original 13 Colonies

Fold 3 paper bags and staple them together in the middle.

For each page you will have a colony then answer the four questions.

Who started the colony?

Why did they start the colony?

What year was it started?

In what ways did they cooperate or have conflict with Native Americans and between and among the new settlers?

Then add a picture and additional important information about the colony.
For example that they mostly grew tobacco crops and a picture of a tobacco leaf.
